

Erasmus + DigiT-T: *Digital Manufacturing Training System for SMEs*



March 5, 2020:

Demonstration of the online training platform aimed at supporting SMEs in their training path concerning Digital Manufacturing

On March 5, 2020, the online training platform (<https://training.digit-t.eu/>), developed in the context of the Erasmus + project ***Digit-T – Digital Manufacturing Training System for SMEs***, has been demonstrated in the context of the Advanced Factories in Barcelona (<https://www.advancedfactories.com/>), one of the main EU exhibition dedicated to the topics of Industry 4.0 with almost 17.305 professionals attending the 2020 edition.

Throughout the day, the Digit-T online training platform has been introduced and demonstrated providing to attendees an overview of the developed training topics.

The Digit-T project ([website](#)), coordinated by the Institute for Advanced Manufacturing of the University of Nottingham, and with the participation of the STIIMA Institute of the National Research Council, AFIL - the Lombardy Intelligent Factory Association and Eurecat (Spain) is aimed at supporting SMEs in their transaction path towards the “Digital Manufacturing” through the provision of specific training modules, made available through an specifically developed online platform.

In the detail, the main topics addressed by the Digit-T project, opportunely detailed through dedicated modules, are: **i)** Management in I4.0; **ii)** Advanced Manufacturing Systems and **iii)** Intelligent Robotics.
